#### Our top tips for choosing your colours

- Keep it simple, less is more.
- Shadows and the angles of walls in a room can create so many different perceived shades from one colour. So it's a good idea to apply a sample or move your colour card to different areas of a room before making your final decision.
- Look at your samples at different times of the day and night as different lighting can make a big difference to how you perceive your colour.
- A colour that looks great on a colour card can sometimes look overpowering when the whole room is painted with it. If you are feeling adventurous use the features of the room to guide you. If there's a dado rail it provides a great opportunity to have a bolder colour above or below it and a more subtle one the other side. Alternatively you might want to have a subtle colour on the walls but then pick out the woodwork in something other than white for contrast.
- A good way to include bolder colours is as a feature wall. These are often the wall behind the bed in a bedroom, the chimney breast, or the recess walls either side of the chimney breast. These can add depth to a room and provide a point of interest without being overpowering.
- Juxtaposition is key to how you perceive your colours. If you are planning more than one colour in a room, even if one of the colours is white, try them next to each other. A blue next to a cream can look very different to the same blue next to a white.

**All colours are currently available in three finishes – matt emulsion, wipeable emulsion and eggshell.**

**Matt emulsion:** A matt finish suitable for all walls and ceilings.

Available in **5 Litres** and **2.5 Litres**

**Wipeable emulsion:** Also a matt finish but with a very subtle sheen. Suitable for all walls and ceilings and ideal for areas likely to be scuffed or marked regularly. Rather than having to re-paint, marks can usually be removed with a wipe or slightly damp cloth. It is also suitable for bathrooms and kitchens.

Available in **5 Litres** and **2.5 Litres**

**Eggshell:** A finish that looks a bit like...eggshell. This paint is suitable for interior woodwork (e.g. doors, windows and skirting boards).

Available in **2.5 Litres** and **1 Litre**
